

## **Medicines and other temperature sensitive goods**

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There will normally be regulations relating to the movement of such goods. The supplier or donor of medicines and vaccines, for example, will usually supply information regarding their storage and transport. This is often related to temperature ranges. In some countries refrigerated vehicles or refrigerated containers will be required to transport these items. Some countries will have legislation detailing regulations concerning the movement of chilled and frozen food. Perishable goods may also need to be transported in a temperature controlled environment. It is important that the temperature is controlled all along the chain.
